Gunter currently holds the position of 'Head of Unit' of Integrated Security Policy. This unit prepares the policy concerning security and prevention for the Belgian Minister of Home Affairs by means of projects, scientific research, crime and security analysis. In this context, a project was started aiming at reducing theft of cargo on parking areas along the Belgian highways in 2006. This project was developed in strong collaboration with all relevant partners (police services, private security association, transport associations, insurance associations, regional governments, customs). The major aim of the project is to reduce crime.

Other activities of the Unit Integrated Security Policy include: increasing security of professions at risk (general practitioners, pharmacists), enhancing abilities of youngsters to resist crime, reducing theft of metal (copper), prevention radicalisation and polarisation, administrative measures on tackling crime, international police cooperation, Schengen border control.
